The White County Steering Committee A met on Monday, January 4, 2020, at the White County Courthouse. Members of Committee A include Commissioners Lanny Selby, Chairman, Dillard Quick, Cain Rogers, Terry Alley, Lonnie Crouch, Lee Broyles, and Bobby McCulley.

Chairman Selby called the meeting to order and requested roll call. Members present include, Lanny Selby, Chairman, Dillard Quick, Cain Rogers, and Lonnie Selby. Absent were Commissioners Bobby McCulley, Terry Alley, Lee Broyles. Also present were County Executive, Denny W. Robinson and Gaylen Barlow. There being a quorum, the meeting continued with opening prayer led by Commissioner Lonnie Crouch.

Chairman Selby asked for review and approval of the Minutes from the December 7th, 2020 meeting. With no discussion, Commissioner Crouch made a motion and Commissioner Quick seconded the motion to approve the Minutes as presented. With no objections the motion was approved.

Chairman Selby open the floor by requesting an update from the Parks and Rec Sub-Committee. Prior to the meeting, Commissioner Mason stated that White County was one of two counties that was selected to apply for the Healthy Built Grant that helps pay to ensure that citizens have areas to exercise in an outdoor space. The committee members were asked to collect recommendation letters from businesses and churches in the community and this had to be completed by the end of January to submit in the application part of this grant. Commissioner Quick also brought up the grant for Mitchells Ford Kayak Launch and recommended Jimmy Culver to pour the concrete for the picnic tables. The P&R committee is scheduled to meet Monday, January 11th at 6:00pm at the WC Courthouse.

The 2021 White County Roads list was received by Clay Parker, W.C. Highway Dept. and the Roads List was submitted to the Committee for approval. Commissioner Cain Rogers made a motion to adopt and send the 2021 County Roads List to full court, this motion was seconded by Commissioner Lonnie Crouch, none opposed and motion was approved

In further discussion, Executive Robinson brought a request from local resident, Julie Henson to close a portion H & H Road, a current county road in White County. The western end of H & H Road will be shortened by 0.188 miles making the official length 0.112. After discussion,

Commissioner Cain Rogers made a motion and Commissioner Dillard Quick seconded the motion to send the resolution to full court on Monday, January 25th, 2021, 2020 for further review and discussion; Rogers seconded the motion. With no objections, the motion was approved.

Old Business – Chairman Selby asked Executive Robinson if any changes had been made to reduce electricity bill at the White County Animal Shelter. Executive Robinson stated that he was still working on some different ways or ideas to help improve that utility bill so the shelter could run more efficiently.

New Business – Commissioner Cain Rogers proposed that the White County Commission could draft and create a resolution turning Virgin Falls Natural Area into a State Park to be sent to the State Legislature. Executive Robinson stated that he would work on drafting that resolution and bring it before the committee next month. Executive Robinson also gave a health update on Commissioner Terry Alley that is in Cookeville Regional Medical Center, Intensive Care Unit due to COVID-19.

With no further discussion or business, Chairman Selby announced that the White Co. Legislative Body will meet in regular session on Monday, January 25th, at 6pm. This regular called meeting was moved out one (1) week due to the Martin Luther King Jr Holiday.

The next Steering Committee A meeting will be Monday, February 1st, 2021 at 5:30 pm.

There being no further business, Commissioner Rogers made a motion and Commissioner Quick seconded to adjourn. With no objections, the motion was approved.

The White County Steering Committee B met on Monday, January 4, 2021 at the White County Courthouse. Members of Committee B include, Commissioners Robert McCormick, Chairman, Andy Haston, Vice Chairman, Dakota White, Secretary, Stanley Neal, Roger Mason, T.K. Austin, and Dale Bennett

Chairman McCormick opened the meeting and requested roll call. Members present were Commissioners McCormick, Haston, White, Neal, Mason, and Austin. Absent was Commissioner Bennett. Also present was Chad Marcum, Finance Director. There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order and prayer was led by Commissioner White.

Chairman McCormick asked for review and approval of the Report from the December 7, 2020 Steering B meeting. Commissioner Austin made a motion and Commissioner Mason seconded the motion to approve the Report as presented. The motion was approved by all members.

Chairman McCormick opened the floor for old business to be presented by the committee. Commissioner Neal asked if there was an update from the *Health & Safety (HSE)* sub-committee. Commissioner Austin reported that the committee was waiting to hear back from the State of TN regarding the variance that was submitted. Commissioner Mason reported that he or a member of the HSE sub-committee would meet with Executive Robinson and ask Executive Robinson for a status update regarding hiring a Codes Enforcement Officer. There was no further discussion or action taken.

Chairman McCormick opened the floor or new business to be presented by the committee. Commissioner Neal reported that the newly formed *Fire Services Study Committee* met earlier on 01/04/2021 and discussed the duties and expectations of the sub-committee. Neal further stated that the *Fire Services Study Committee* will meet next on January 14, 2021 and again on January 28, 2021. A summary of these meetings will be presented to Steering Committee B at the February 1, 2021 meeting. There was no further discussion or action taken.

Additionally, in new business, Commissioner Neal reported that he had recently spoken with the director of the local Health Dept. after receiving many complaints regarding the Health Departments failure to effectively communicate clinic hours, testing schedules and vaccine administration to local officials and to the citizens of White County. Commissioner Neal reported that he is hopeful that the issue will be resolved and there will be a clearer line of communication from Health Dept. officials in the future. There was no further discussion or action taken.

The White County Solid Waste committee met Monday, January 5, 2021 at the White County Courthouse. Members of Solid Waste Committee are Commissioners Dillard Quick, Chairman, Andy Haston, T.K. Austin, Lanny Selby, Bobby McCulley, Robert McCormick, and Lee Broyles.

Chairman Quick requested roll call of committee members. Present were Commissioners Dillard Quick, Lanny Selby, Robert McCormick, Andy Haston, and T.K. Austin. Absent were Commissioners Lee Broyles, and Bobby McCulley. Also present were County Executive, Denny W. Robinson, and Gaylen Barlow, Solid Waste Director and Chad Marcum, Finance Director. There being a quorum, the meeting was called to order.

Chairman Quick opened the floor by requesting review, discussion, and approval of the Minutes from the December 7th meeting. With no discussion, Commissioner Austin made a motion and Commissioner Robert McCormick seconded the motion to approve the Minutes as presented. With no objections the motion was approved.

Chairman Quick requested the Directors report from Solid Waste Director, Gaylen Barlow. Barlow reported that the White County Landfill was broken into on January 2nd, 2021, the perpetrator(s) stole 2 pick-up trucks and a camera system out of one of the front-end trucks and other miscellaneous items were also stolen. The main Class I compactor is broken down and is currently waiting on parts to be fixed. Barlow also stated that they have been receiving up to 150 to 200 tons a day of Class I waste.

Executive Robinson reviewed the Engineers report from TriAd with members. According to the report for the Class III/IV Vertical Expansion, TriAd received some minor comments from TDEC on the Class III/IV Vertical Expansion Application. TriAd is making the necessary revisions and will resubmit the application for approval within the next week. In regards to the Class I Landfill Expansion/Hydrogeologic Investigation The drilling company finished the additional borings/piezometers on December 23rd. Initial water measurements within the borings/piezometers at completion and on December 30th were promising (i.e., significantly below the ground surface). TriAd will continue to monitor the water elevations in the new piezometers over the next two months. As stated in our previous update, we hope to have approval of the hydrogeologic investigation by April 1, 2021. Vick Surveying is scheduled to pick up the elevations of the new piezometers in the coming weeks so we can tie our water measurements to ground surface elevations. While Vick Surveying is on-site, they are going to survey the active Class I landfill to determine the remaining landfill volume. TriAD is coordinating with Tradebe to complete the leachate line jetting; Tradebe anticipates being onsite within the month.

Old Business: There was no old business brought to the committee for discussion

<u>New Business</u>: There was discussion on Solid Waste fee but no action taken at this time. Discussion on tires and a chipper for the tires but no action was taken at this time.

With no other announcements or business, Chairman Quick announced that the White Co. Legislative Body will meet in regular session on Monday, January 25th, 2021 at 6pm. The regular called meeting of the Legislative Body was moved back a week due to the Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.

The next Solid Waste Committee meeting will be Monday, February 5th, 2021 immediately following Steering A meeting.

There being no further business, Commissioner Selby made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Commissioner Haston. With no objections, the meeting was adjourned.

Budget Committee Meeting

The White County Budget Committee met on Monday, January 4, 2021 following the Solid Waste Committee at the White County Courthouse. Members present were Mr. Andy Haston, Mr. Stanley Neal, Mr. Cain Rogers, and Mr. Denny Wayne Robinson. Also present were Mr. Chad Marcum, Mr. TK Austin, and Mr. Roger Mason. Absent was Mr. Bobby McCulley.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Mr. Robinson.

Mr. Robinson asked for approval of the minutes from the December 9, 2020 meeting. Mr. Neal made a motion and Mr. Haston seconded the motion to approve the minutes as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a General Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$3,376 to appropriate funding for the employer's portion of Social Security and Medicare tax paid on wages in compliance with the settlement agreement approved by the White County Commission on August 17, 2020 in the matter of Jewell Bilbrey, Craig Capps, Daniel Haggard, Chris Isom, Greg Matthews, Shannon Jenkins, and Jimmy Hill vs. White County, Tennessee and Sheriff Steve Page. This amount was inadvertently left out of the budget amendment approved by the White County Commission on October 19, 2020 for the settlement agreement. Mr. Rogers made a motion and Mr. Haston seconded the motion to approve the budget amendment as presented and recommend its passage by the full county commission. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a Highway/Public Works Fund line-item budget amendment in the amount of \$35,500 to reallocate funding for projects and liability insurance as well as a Solid Waste Disposal Fund line-item budget amendment in the amount of \$1,000 for liability insurance. Mr. Neal made a motion and Mr. Rogers seconded the motion to approve the budget amendments as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a General Purpose School Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$1,200 to appropriate a donation from Caney Fork Electric Cooperative. Mr. Haston made a motion and Mr. Rogers seconded the motion to approve the budget amendment as presented and recommend its passage by the full county commission, contingent upon School Board approval. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered the Fiscal Year 2022 budget preparation calendar. Mr. Rogers made a motion and Mr. Neal seconded the motion to approve the Fiscal Year 2022 budget preparation calendar as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Robinson asked the committee for any old business: There was none.

Mr. Robinson asked the committee for any new business:

The committee held a general discussion regarding Parks and Recreation activities with Mr. Roger Mason who serves on the Parks and Recreation sub-committee. No formal action was taken.

After discussion, the next meeting was set for Monday, February 1, 2021 following Solid Waste Committee.

There being no further business, Mr. Rogers made a motion and Mr. Neal seconded the motion to adjourn. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

RESOLUTION NO. 12-01-2021

To Apply for Community Development Block Grant Funds

WHEREAS, White County, Tennessee, is eligible for grant funds under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program administered by the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development; and

WHEREAS, White County needs improved fire protection to meet the needs of the citizens of the county; and

WHEREAS, fire protection projects are eligible activities under the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, White County Tennessee, is eligible for a maximum grant of four hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$420,000) under the Community Development Block Grant Community Livability category including the Three-Star bonus of twenty thousand (\$20,000.00); and

WHEREAS, White County has agreed to pay the required 13% of the total project cost (based on the White County 21% Ability-to-Pay rate with the ThreeStar 4-point and COVID-19 4-point match reductions), plus any additional funding required to complete the project beyond the grant amount.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the White County Commission that:

- 1. The County Executive be authorized and directed to:
 - A. Execute and submit an application for Community Development Block Grant funds to the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development in order to provide fire protection through mini-pumpers for the community.
