There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Vice-Chariman, Don Percy, and prayer was led by Commissioner Kyle Goff.

Approval of June Report:

Vice-Chariman Percy opened the floor for approval of the June Report from the June 17th, 2024 meeting.

Mr. McBride made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, seconded by Commissioner Goff. With no further discussion, the motion was unanimously approved.

Discussion on The White County Youth Baseball League:

Vice-Chariman Percy recognized that several members of the public were in attendance to address concerns regarding White County Youth Baseball. Percy acknowledged audience members to speak and express concerns.

Mr. Zac Madden was the primary spokesperson for the group. He stated that the league had over 650 children the previous season but the current structure is not sustainable nor amenable to future growth. The primary concerns circled around field conditions, the need for additional fields and the accessibility of the fields to the public when not in use by the league. The concern was also expressed that there is no current contract between White County and Youth Baseball as the previous lease agreement has expired. Commissioner Goff expressed the need for all entities using White County property to sign a memorandum of understanding. Mr. Kurt Dronebarger requested that the County Attorney review the previous agreement and make recommendations on moving forward. Mr. Dronebarger also expressed a desire to see the fields more accessible to

the public. Mr. Percy assured this could be made possible and asked the members of the audience to contact him directly for access. Regarding field conditions, Highway Superintendent, Jerry Sawyer, stated that an engineer is looking at drainage and irrigation to assess what is needed.

After other discussion, Vice-Chairman Percy thanked the members of the audience for coming to address the committee.

Discussion on Snake Ridge Bike Trail:

Commissioner Becky Golden stated that the MOU with Upper Cumberland Southern Off-Road Bicycle Association (UCSORBA) was not approved in Steering Committee A due to lack of a second and about next steps. Executive Robinson stated that since the MOU holds no financial ramifications approval by Steering Committee A is not required. Mr. Dronebarger expressed the desire to continue to research the possibility of a different entrance for bikes to ameliorate concerns regarding crossover of archery meets and those using the bicycle trail.

Discussion on David Culley Sportsplex Signage:

Vice-Chairman Percy recommended that the conversation regarding signage at the David Culley Sportsplex be tabled considering the absence of Commissioner Roger Mason.

Old Business:

Vice-Chairman Percy opened the floor for old business to come before the committee.

Commissioner Kyle Goff asked that the YMCA Program Director, Virginia Skinner, be allowed to address the committee regarding electricity at the YMCA soccer fields being used on County Property on Walker Street, directly behind the old WCMS gymnasium. Skinner stated that committee had approved \$2,000 for the project and the YMCA had received a quote from Cherry Creek Electric for \$4,600. She stated the need for electricity for lighting of the field for afternoon games and practices.

Commissioner Golden made a motion that the County fund the project in the full amount of \$4,600, seconded by Travis McBride. During discussion period, Executive Robinson requested the YMCA consult with Sparta Electric to make sure there are no other underlying issues that will hinder the project before moving forward. Commissioner Golden moved to amend the motion on the floor to include a contingency that the YMCA consult Sparta Electric before moving forward, seconded by Travis McBride. With no further discussion, the motion was approved with 4 of 5 members voting in the affirmative. Commissioner Goff abstained and recused himself from the vote.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the White County Commission, meeting in a regularly scheduled meeting, as follows:




RESOLUTION TO AMEND FISCAL YEAR 2025 GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUND


WHEREAS, the budget of White County is made a year in advance and is basically an estimate of revenues and expenditures that will be available and required for that year, AND





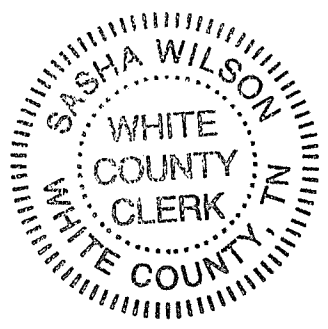
