The White County *Nominating Committee* met on Tuesday, September 6, 2022 at 5:00pm at the White County Courthouse. Prayer was led by Roger Mason.

County Executive, Denny Wayne Robinson welcomed senior members of the White County Commission who will serve as the 2022/2023 Nominating Committee and requested roll call. Commissioners present included Commissioners Robert McCormick, Kyle Goff, Roger Mason, T.K. Austin, Jordan Cocke, and Lanny Selby, absent was Commissioner Cain Rogers. Others in attendance included, Denny Wayne Robinson, County Executive, Commissioners, Becky Golden, David Cranford, Dakota White, Chris Brewington, Derrick Hutchings, Larry Daniels, and Thomas Margeson. Also present was citizen, Connie Davis. There being a quorum the meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Executive Robinson.

Chairman of Nominating Committee

Mr. Robinson opened the floor for nominations for Chairman of the Nominating Committee. Commissioner McCormick nominated Commissioner T.K. Austin as Chairman. With no other nominations Commissioner Mason made a motion that all nominations cease and Mr. Austin be elected by acclamation, seconded by Mr. McCormick; with no objections the motion was approved.

V. Chairman of Nominating Committee

Chairman Austin opened the floor for nominations for Vice Chairman of the Nominating Committee. Commissioner McCormick nominated Commissioner Kyle Goff as Vice Chairman. With no other nominations Commissioner Mason made a motion that all nominations cease and Mr. Goff be elected by acclamation, seconded by Commissioner Selby; with no objections the motion was approved.

Secretary of Nominating Committee:

Chairman Austin opened the floor for three (3) nominations and one (1) White County citizen nomination to serve on the Audit Committee. Commissioner Mason nominated Commissioners, Dakota White, Kyle Goff, & T.K. Austin. He also nominated citizen Michael Lewis for re-appointment. With no other nominations Mr. Selby made a motion for all nominations to cease and Commissioners, White, Goff, Austin & Lewis to be elected by acclamation. Motion seconded by Mr. McCormick; with no objections the motion was approved.

Purchasing Committee: Appoint Two (2) Members

Chairman Austin opened the floor for two (2) nominations for the Purchasing Committee. Mr. McCormick nominated Lanny Selby and Larry Daniels. With no other nominations Mr. McCormick made a motion for all nominations to cease and Commissioners, Selby and Daniels be elected by acclamation, seconded by Commissioner Cocke; with no objections the motion was approved.

Commissioner Goff made a motion that all nominations cease and **Commissioners, Rogers, Austin, Golden, Selby, Margeson, Hutchings, and Daniels** to be elected by acclamation to serve as member of Steering A Committee, seconded by Mr. Selby; with no objections the motion was approved. Commissioner McCormick made a motion that the remaining members including Commissioners, Brewington, Cranford, McCormick, White, Cocke, Mason, & Goff be elected by acclamation to serve as members of the Steering B Committee, seconded by Mr. Mason; with no objections the motion was approved.

Solid Waste: Appoint (7) Members

Chairman Austin opened the floor for seven (7) nominations to serve on the Solid Waste Committee. Commissioner Goff nominated Commissioners, Austin, Hutchings, Brewington, White, Cocke, Daniels, and Golden. With no other nominations Commissioner Mason made a motion that all nominations cease and Commissioners, Austin, Hutchings, Brewington, White, Cocke, Daniels, and Golden be elected by acclamation, seconded by Commissioner McCormick; with no objections the motion was approved.

Dear Mr. Robinson and Members of the White County Commission:

This letter is to inform you that our office received a complaint alleging that the White County Commission may be acting in violation of the Tennessee Open Meetings Act ("TOMA"). Specifically, a concerned citizen alleges that the Commission is engaging in deliberations outside of public meetings by conducting meetings prior to the properly noticed start time.

When this office receives a complaint regarding a possible open meetings violation, our routine practice is to contact the governing body to make the members aware that a complaint was received and to advise as to the requirements of Tennessee's open meetings laws. As such, I write to inform you of the concerns presented and to review the requirements of the law.

TOMA provides that the formation of public policy is public business and shall not be conducted in secret. Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-44-101. To effectuate this purpose, TOMA requires that all meetings of a governing body, such as the White County Commission, must be open to the public except in very limited circumstances. Tenn. Code Ann. § 8-44-102. The Tennessee Court of Appeals has made it clear that two or more members of a governing body cannot discuss or deliberate public business, which a majority of the governing body would need to vote upon, outside of an open public meeting. *Neese v. Paris Special School District*, 813 S.W.2d 432, 436 (Tenn. Ct. App. 1990); *Johnston v. Metropolitan Government of Nashville*, 320 S.W.3d 299, 312 (Tenn. Ct. App. 2009). Accordingly, the Commission's deliberations should occur only at a properly noticed open public meeting. Additionally, two or more members of the Council should not discuss or deliberate matters outside a properly noticed open public meeting.

Any action taken by a governing body at a meeting in violation of TOMA is void. A governing body may properly ratify such action by subjecting the action to new and substantial consideration during an open public meeting. However, courts have still found violations and imposed sanctions even where a governing body properly ratifies actions taken outside an open public meeting. Our office would recommend consulting with the county attorney regarding the foregoing allegations, as TOMA does allow citizens to file a lawsuit when they believe an open meetings violation has occurred. If a lawsuit is filed, a court will determine whether a violation occurred based upon the facts presented to the court. Should the court determine a violation occurred, it can issue injunctions against the members of the governing body, and the governing body would be subject to the court's supervision for a year from the date of the entry of judgment.

Adopting 2018 Edition of the International Residential Building Code

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated (TCA) §5-20-102 authorizes the governing body of any county of the State of Tennessee to adopt by reference the provisions of any code properly identified as to date and source, AND

WHEREAS, TCA §5-20-101 defines “code” as any published compilation of rules and regulations that has been prepared by technical trade associations or model code organizations regulating building construction, plumbing and gas installation, fire prevention, any portion of such rules, or any amendment of such rules, AND

WHEREAS, Resolution 53-08-2022 of the White County Legislative Body appointed a Building Inspector for White County under the authority granted it by TCA 5-20-103, AND

WHEREAS, TCA §5-20-103 and 5-20-104 authorize White County to confer the powers and duties of enforcing the provisions of any code properly adopted upon a county official, AND

WHEREAS, the following Residential Building Codes are already in effect and are being enforced locally by the State of Tennessee. The passage of this resolution is required for counties who are considering local enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the White County Legislative Body, meeting in regularly scheduled session that:

Section 1. The 2018 International Residential Code (IRC) as published by the International Code Council (ICC) establishing guidelines for the construction of residential structures be adopted as the residential building code for White County.

Section 2. The 2009 R-value energy charts shall be adopted for energy code requirements.

Section 3. An amendment be established to exempt single family dwellings from the requirement of a sprinkler system.

Section 4. An amendment be established to exempt the requirement for the use R-19 insulation in the floor joints of vented crawl spaces.

Section 5. The powers and duties of enforcing the provisions this code and any amendment be conferred upon the Director of Building Codes for White County.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect upon passage and satisfaction of any requirements as outlined in Tennessee Code Annotated.


