

Lisa Luck from the Upper Cumberland Development District was present to present the review of our Annual Progress Report. The County has been successful in diverting at least 25% of our solid waste from the landfill to recycling.

The White County Solid Waste Committee met on Monday, April 1, 2019 immediately following The Regional Solid Waste Board at the White County Courthouse. Members present were Stanley Neal, Robert McCormick, Roger Mason, Dale Bennett and TK Austin. Also present were Finance Director Chad Marcum, Landfill Director Gaylon Barlow, County Executive Denny Robinson and Lisa Luck. Absent was Andy Haston and Dakota White.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Dale Bennett. Mr. Bennett asked for approval of the minutes from the previous meeting. Commissioner Mason made a motion and Commissioner Austin seconded the motion to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was approved.

Directors Report:

Director Barlow updated the committee on the progress of the new class 1 cell permitting process. Mr. Barlow informed the committee that the engineers had begun the ecological evaluation and were actively core drilling in the proposed expansion area for the new cell.

Mr. Barlow informed the committee that we do have an additional front end truck on the road while the truck that we have purchased is being repaired. The front end truck we are currently using is free rental due to the repair that is being made on the truck we purchased. Once the repairs are made, the County will have a completely refurbished truck for \$95k. Mr. Barlow went on to say our front end truck that broke down last month is currently being repaired. He further stated that according to King's Truck Service, the oil pump had quit working. Mr. Barlow stated the truck's engine will be rebuilt and this will become our back up truck. Commissioner Mason ask if we would need a resolution to sell the oldest truck on GovDeals. Executive Robinson confirmed the committee would need to send a resolution to full court to surplus the truck to sell it on GovDeals.

Commissioner Austin inquired on the progress of the Leachate Collection Sump repair. Mr. Barlow reported that the bids were due Friday, April 5, 2019.

Engineer's Report:

Executive Robinson reported to the committee that he met with our engineering firm, TriAd Environmental, today. Mr. Robinson states that he discussed with our engineers problems with the current cell and ways to prevent those issues from happening with the new cell. Specifically, there was discussion on how we can maximize the cell's full life capacity and better ways to manage our municipal waste. He further explained that our engineers suggested we go ahead and permit approximately 25 acres initially and then work in strategic phases or smaller cells to maximize the full use of our land.

Mr. Robinson stated he discussed the pros and cons of using a tarp system for cover instead of the clay dirt with the engineers. TriAd suggested we contact a few of the tarp companies to see if they would be interested in conducting a demo of the tarp system with our current cell.

The committee discussed the leachate collection system for the new cell. Mr. Robinson explained that the system was gravity flow to a sump inside the new cell, then would be pumped out to the leachate collection tanks.

Chairman Bennett asked the committee for any old business, there was none.

Chairman Bennett asked the committee for any new business. Chairman Bennett ask the committee if they wanted to have their next meeting at the landfill. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Mason made a motion to invite Steering Committee A to have a joint A and B meeting on May 6th, 2019 at the landfill with the Solid Waste meeting to follow. Commissioner Austin seconded the motion. On a voice call vote, the motion was approved.

The committee reviewed the Fiscal Year 2020 County General Fund budget increase requests. The committee also discussed specific salary increases made by various departments as well as the potential impact an across the board raise would have on the proposed budget.

After much discussion regarding the requests, the committee determined it best to have the following departments appear before the committee: Sheriff's Department/Jail (Corrections), EMS (Ambulance Service), Juvenile Services, and Election Commission. The committee asked Mr. Marcum to communicate their desire to meet with these departments.

Mr. Mason asked the committee for any old business: There was none.

The committee considered a General Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$3,482 to appropriate funds required to maintain the two part-time positions at the White County Animal Shelter through June 30, 2019, in the event that donated funds are discontinued. WHEREAS, White County must count every resident in order to be fully represented in both the Tennessee General Assembly and the United States Congress; and


WHEREAS, low response rates can result in undercounts of population and affect Congressional apportionment and funding levels for local programs; and





2. The Fiscal Year 2018-2019 General Fund Budget is hereby amended as follows to allow for this action to be carried out:






