

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Dale Bennett and prayer was led by Al Klee.



Mr. Barlow presented the committee with a cost saving idea regarding cardboard recycling. He would like to replace the open roll off cans with front end cans designed to receive cardboard. The cans are cost effective. They are designed to only receive cardboard that has been broken-down which would create space and cut down on excessive trips emptying the larger roll off containers. Less trips would create a cost savings in fuel, labor and maintenance on roll off trucks.

**WHEREAS**, the Tennessee Attorney General opined the Opinion No. 92.47 that state and local governments are required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Acts in administering federally funded programs; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development Division of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development administers the Three-Star Program and awards financial incentives for the communities designated as Three-Star Communities; and,

**WHEREAS**, by virtue of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development receiving federal financial assistance all communities designated as Three-Star Communities must confirm that the community is in compliance with the regulations of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the White County Legislative Body, meeting in regular session on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2017 that:

Section 1: The legislative body of White County declares that the county is in compliance with federal Title VI regulations.

Section 2: The Department of Economic and Community Development may from time to time monitor the county's compliance with federal Title VI regulations.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption, the public welfare requiring it.


