The White County Steering A Committee met on Monday, February 3, 2020, at the White County Courthouse. **Members present were Commissioners Stanley Neal, Chairman, Roger Mason, Andy Haston, Dakota White, Robert McCormick and T.K. Austin. Absent, Commissioner Dale Bennett.**

Also present were Wayne Jeffery, WC Resident, Ron Moses, Sparta Expositor, Bill Loos, Chad Marcum, Finance Director and several unidentified guests.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Chairman Neal and prayer was led by Commissioner Roger Mason.

Chairman Neal asked members to review the Minutes from the January meeting and opened the floor for any discussion. There being no discussion, Neal entertained a motion to approve the Minutes as presented. Commissioner Mason made a motion to approve the Minutes as presented, Commissioner White seconded the motion, none opposed, and motion was approved to accept the Minutes as presented.

In order of the Agenda, business discussed included:

Parks & Recreation Sub-Committee Update

Commissioner Mason reported that the P&R sub-committee met prior to this evenings Steering A meeting. Mason reported that officers were elected for the 2019-2020 P&R term and are as follows:

Jason Stevenson, Vice Chairman

Roger Mason, Secretary

The P&R sub-committee will meet again on Thursday, March 5, 2020 at 6pm in Rm 222 at the White County Courthouse.

Pyro Contract for Independence Celebration

A contract and invoice from Pyro Shows was presented to members for review and consideration to conduct the fireworks show at the 2020 Independence Celebration, July 3, 2020. Commissioner Mason asked Finance Director, Chad Marcum if the contract would need to be sent to Budget Committee. Marcum stated that funds were already allocated under the P&R budget and no further action would be necessary. Kim England, Executive Assistant relayed updates received from Chirstpoint Church and their intent to recruit sponsors to help underwrite some of the other expenses for the event. Based on the success of last year's event, Chairman, Neal entertained a motion to contract with Pryo Shows again this year and pay a total of \$15,000 for the fireworks display (\$7,500 to be paid at the time of signing, and the balance paid prior to the event). Commissioner Mason made a motion to approve and

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accept the contract terms, seconded by Commissioner White, with no further discussion, the motion was approved with none opposed.

WC Library Update

Commissioner Mason stated that the WC Library board recently met and reported that the WC Library will receive an in-kind donation (labor) from TDOC inmates to paint the library and clean off the overgrown vegetation on the banks around the library. Inmates from Bledsoe Co. Prison will begin work within the next few weeks (weather permitting).

Other updates reported included the announcement of Ms. Cathy Farley being elected to serve as the Director of Libraries for the State of TN. Ms. Farley will continue to serve in her role at the local library.

The White County Library continues to seek dedicated board members to serve.

US Census 2020 Update

Kim England, Executive Assistant gave an update from the local Complete Count Committee (CCC) that included the opportunity to apply for, newly announced funding, to assist with Census participation in hard to count communities. England confirmed that the *Intent to Apply* had been submitted and it was the overall consensus of the CCC to apply for \$10,000 to purchase tablets/laptops (mobile technology) that can be used in all districts to promote Census participation in the hard-to-count areas. Additionally, money would be used for promo items, printing and setting up Response Centers that will aide people with their Census submissions. England announced the next CCC meeting would be Wed, Feb 12 at 12:30pm at the White Co. Courthouse.

Residential Building Permits Update

Kim England reported that the application to become an Issuing Agent had been approved by the State of Tn and training would be provided by the State on Tuesday, February 18, 2020 at White Co Courthouse. Once training is completed, the State of Tn should release necessary software to enter and issue permits and a final contract. It is projected that by March 2020, applications for Residential Building Permits will be issued from the White Co Executive's Office.

Sales Tax Referendum

Commissioner Mason presented a flier he drafted and spoke of his plans to distribute it among constituents in his district. The Sales Tax Referendum is on the ballot for the upcoming Primary Election. No further discussion or action taken.

Re-naming Public Roads

Executive Robinson spoke to members about there not being an official policy to re-name roads in White County. He presented a policy used by other counties as a sample and asked Commissioners to review and consider drafting a formal policy that would include clear language about the costs and inconveniences to residents when re-naming roads.

Old Business

Commissioner Austin asked for updates on determining classification of roads. Executive Robinson clarified that based on his findings, all guidelines or changes would require approval from Road Superintendent, Clay Parker. Commissioner Mason asked what the result(s) or process would be IF the WC Legislative Body did not approve the Highway Departments Road Lists. Executive Robinson agreed to make inquiry and report back.

Commissioner Mason requested that County Attorney, John Meadows review the documents presented at previous meeting regarding Center Point Ln and offer some direction or a recommendation as to what the county or the residents of that area can do to address the upkeep or maintenance of roads that appear to have fallen off the Roads List.

New Business

Mr. Wayne Jeffery, resident of White County addressed the committee with concerns about Coal Bank/ Idlewild Road. He presented pictures and explanation about the "narrow road" and recalled a number of mishaps that he has witnessed due to speeding and a sharp narrow curve, stating the width of the road is only 17.5' wide. Mr. Jeffery requested that speed limit signs be installed, and consideration be given to changing the road to a one-way. Commissioner White agreed to discuss the issues with Clay Parker and members of the Home Association and report back to Mr. Jeffery and the committee by next meeting.

Commissioner Neal reported that reflective markings and signs have been installed on Black Oak/Swamp Rd.

Commissioner Neal passed out a map of Guhse Rd. (leading into the ball fields off Hwy 70). Neal recommended that members consider adopting Guhse Rd. and adding it to the WC approved Roads List. Guhse runs through county owned property. He further stated that it may be possible to obtain state aide that could be used for paving and repairs to the road. Executive Robinson noted that as of now, Guhse Rd could be closed off during events, if adopted it could not be closed off during events, tournaments, etc. No action was taken by members.

Chad Marcum, Finance Director presented Items to Surplus. Items listed included equipment from Central Maintenance, EMS and Highway departments. A motion was made by Commissioner Austin to surplus the list of equipment, seconded by Commissioner White, none opposed, and motion was approved.

Ms. Lisa Luck with UCDD assists with preparation and will address the Solid Waste Committee at the next meeting scheduled March 2, 2020.

The committee considered a General Fund line item budget amendment in the amount of \$20,000 to reallocate funds within the Sheriff's Department major category for overtime pay due to vacancies within the full-time road deputy positions. The committee considered a Highway/Public Works Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$442,111 to recognize revenue and expenditures for the Fiscal Year 2019 State Aid Paving program. Mr. Neal made a motion and Mr. Haston seconded the motion to approve the amendment as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a General Capital Projects Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$250,000 to recognize a state grant for the construction and renovation of the White County Health Department. Mr. Haston made a motion and Mr. Robinson seconded the motion to approve the amendment as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a General Purpose School Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$435,000 to appropriate funds required to comply with White County Commission Resolution 01-01-2020, for an agreement with the City of Sparta for closure of Sidney Lane. Mr. Neal made a motion and Mr. Mason seconded the motion to approve the amendment as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was approved 3 to 1 with Mr. Haston casting the dissenting vote.





Resolution to Approve a Continuous Five (5) Year Reappraisal Cycle

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated Section 67-5-1601 establishes a general six (6) year reappraisal for updating and equalizing property values for every county in Tennessee for property tax purposes, **AND**:

WHEREAS, a six (6) year reappraisal program consists of an on-site review of each parcel of real property over a five-year period followed by revaluation of all such property in the year following completion of the review period and includes a current value updating during the third year of the review cycle and sales ratio studies during the second and fifth years of the review cycle; **AND**:

WHEREAS, Chapter 318 of the 1997 Public Acts provides upon the approval of the assessor and upon the adoption by majority approval vote of the county legislative body, the reappraisal program may be completed by a continuous five (5) year cycle comprised of an on- site review of each real property over a four (4) year period followed by revaluation of all such property in the year following completion of the review period, **AND**;

WHEREAS, the county legislative body of White County understands that by approving such a five (5) year reappraisal cycle a sales ratio study will be conducted during the second and fourth years of the review cycle and the centrally assessed properties and commercial/industrial tangible personal property will be equalized by the sales ratio adopted by the State Board of Equalization;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the county legislative body of White County, meeting in regular session on this the 24 day of February, 2020 that:

PURSUANT to Tennessee Code Annotated Section 67-5-1601, as amended by Chapter 318 of the 1997 Public Acts, reappraisal shall be accomplished in White County by a continuous five (5) year cycle beginning 07/01/2020 comprised of an on-site review of each parcel of real property over a four (4) year period followed by revaluation of all such property for tax year 2025.
