There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Lanny Selby and prayer was led by Terry Alley.

HSE Updates: Bobby McCulley informed members that the committee approved the job description for the Codes Enforcement officer position. The motion was approved by all members.

Updates of BAM & Humane Society of WC: Lanny Selby informed members they had received cards from the BAM and Humane Society of White County organizations with updates about their organizations.

Old Business: Lanny Selby advised that Stanley Neal is the current interim EMA Director and has obtained a vehicle to use in that capacity. He is handling numerous COVID matters throughout the county.

New Business: Bobby McCulley stated that a few White County citizens were concerned about the Highway Department mowing along the highways and blowing trash in the roadway making a mess that they do not clean up. Mr. McCulley stated he discussed the matter with Highway Superintendent Clay Parker, who was unable and/or unwilling to do anything about the mess the mowing makes. Mr. Marcum addressed the committee regarding finance department operations, including payroll tax disbursements and filings as well as sales tax collections. Mr. Mason asked for approval of the minutes from the August 3, 2020 meeting. Mr. Rogers made a motion and Mr. Haston seconded the motion to approve the minutes as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered approval of the 2020-2021 fiscal year budget for School Federal Projects Fund - Sub-Fund 894 IDEA Innovation Grant in the amount of \$20,000.00. Mr. Haston made a motion and Mr. Neal seconded the motion to approve the budget as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.
