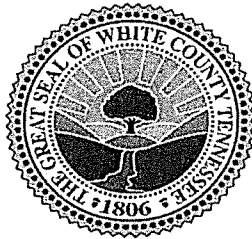

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Lanny Selby and prayer was led by Terry Alley.

Lanny Selby asked for approval of the minutes from the previous meeting. Terry Alley made a motion and Cain Rogers seconded the motion to approve the minutes as presented. The motion was approved by all members.

HSE Updates: Bobby McCulley informed members that the committee approved the job description for the Codes Enforcement officer position. Dillard Quick discussed creating an HSE Committee for handling the codes enforcement officer position. Members discussed putting the matter under Steering Committee B to handle and manage.

Discussion of Part-Time Judicial Commissioner: Terry Alley advised members the matter of hiring a part-time judicial commissioner should be sent to the Budget Committee. Mr. Alley, along with Chad Marcum, informed members that the county had received approval of money earlier in the year, but no one was hired. Members discussed the fact that COVID makes it difficult having only two judicial commissioners. Mr. Marcum advised that the judicial commissioner position pays about \$28,000 per year. Mr. Alley stated the new position should be part-time and have set hours per month. Dillard Quick made a motion and Bobby McCulley seconded the motion to send the matter to Budget Committee. The motion was approved by all members.

Updates of BAM & Humane Society of WC: Lanny Selby informed members they had received cards from the BAM and Humane Society of White County organizations with updates about their organizations.

Old Business: Lanny Selby advised that Stanley Neal is the current interim EMA Director and has obtained a vehicle to use in that capacity. He is handling numerous COVID matters throughout the county.

New Business: Bobby McCulley stated that a few White County citizens were concerned about the Highway Department mowing along the highways and blowing trash in the roadway making a mess that they do not clean up. Mr. McCulley stated he discussed the matter with Highway Superintendent Clay Parker, who was unable and/or unwilling to do anything about the mess the mowing makes. Members discussed the danger it poses to drivers and the legality of the matter. No further action was taken.

Job Description and Duties

Title: Code Enforcement Officer

Classification: Full-time position

Hours: To be determined

Work Conditions: Outdoor/Indoor work during all seasons and weather conditions

Description: Under general supervision of the White County Executive, candidate will perform a variety of duties in support of the county's local Health & Safety code enforcement program; monitors and enforces a variety of applicable ordinances, codes, and regulations related to zoning, land use, building codes, health and safety, blight, and other matters of public concern; as well as, serves as a resource and provides information on health and safety regulations to property owners, residents, and businesses.

The Code Enforcement Officer is responsible for:

- Enforcing provisions of the International Property Maintenance Code
- Receiving and responding to resident complaints and other department reports on alleged violations of health and safety codes.
