White County EMS (WCEMS) is a 911 service. We have almost 28,000 residents, with 1 hospital, and 2 Nursing homes. In 2021 we ran approximately 6200 calls. We work 7 days on and 7 days off. 2 12 hour shifts per day. We have 3 12 hour trucks on days and 2 12 hour trucks on nights. You are required to cover Call while on shift. Day shift has 3 call in crews and nights has 2 call in crews. We also do convalescent and "out of town" calls. There is also opportunity for Overtime.

Job Qualifications/Responsibilities Emergency Medical Technician Critical Care Paramedics

Qualifications:

- Minimum 20 years of age
- Possess and maintain a Tennessee E.M.T.-P license with a Critical Care endorsement
- Must possess and maintain a valid Tennessee driver's license.
- Must have and maintain a safe driving record
- Must pass a pre-employment physical exam
- Must pass pre-employment drug screen
- Must pass background check
- Must pass a physical agility test
- Must have knowledge within their level of licensure
- Must perform skills indicating ability within their level of licensure
- Must not have been convicted of a felony or offenses of violence or moral turpitude

Responsibilities:

- Must provide patient care at their level of licensure
- Maintain a clean working environment (to include ambulance and station).
- Operate the ambulance in a safe manner.
- Must clean and inventory the ambulance within the first 60 minutes of the shift.
- Shall be responsible for inventory and accounting of all drugs on the ambulance
- Return the ambulance to "ready status" as soon as possible after returning to service.
- Execute all forms necessary for patient care according to WCEMS requirements.
- Perform tasks as set forth by Administration, and other documents.
- Must immediately report any actions against your EMT-P license or Driver's license
- Must report any legal actions pending against those licenses'
- Must submit to a Hepatitis B vaccination, or sign a form indicating refusal.
- Must submit copies of updated license, certifications, or authorization
- Must submit to a physical exam when requested
- Must maintain all required training relevant to job responsibilities, or State mandates
- Must maintain proficiency on ALS and BLS skills
- Must maintain proficiency in Surgical Airways
- Must maintain proficiency in Chest Tube Insertion
- Must maintain proficiency in Ventilator Transports
- Must maintain proficiency in all other designated advanced skills, with in a Critical Care Paramedics Scope of practice
