The White County Financial Management Committee met on Wednesday, September 30, 2020 at 12:00 Noon at the White County Courthouse. Members present were Mr. Clay Parker, Mr. Lee Broyles, Mr. Dillard Quick, Mr. Lanny Selby, Mr. Kurt Dronebarger, and Mr. Denny Wayne Robinson. Also present were Mr. Chad Marcum, Mr. James Smith, and Mr. Dan Greene. Absent was Mr. Robert McCormick.

There being a quorum present, the meeting was called to order by Mr. Robinson.

Mr. Robinson asked for approval of the minutes from the August 26, 2020 meeting. Mr. Selby made a motion and Mr. Broyles seconded the motion to approve the minutes as presented. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

Mr. Neal made a motion and Mr. Haston seconded the motion to approve the budget amendment as presented and recommend its passage by the full county commission. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a General Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$150,418 to appropriate funds for compliance with the settlement agreement approved by the White County Commission on August 17, 2020 in the matter of Jewell Bilbrey, Craig Capps, Daniel Haggard, Chris Isom, Greg Matthews, Shannon Jenkins, and Jimmy Hill vs. White County, Tennessee and Sheriff Steve Page. Mr. Robinson made a motion and Mr. Neal seconded the motion to approve the budget amendment as presented and recommend its passage by the full county commission. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a Highway/Public Works Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$20,631 to appropriate insurance proceeds received in fiscal year 2020 for repairs to a backhoe. Mr. Neal made a motion and Mr. Haston seconded the motion to approve the budget amendment as presented and

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recommend its passage by the full county commission. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered a Drug Control Fund budget amendment in the amount of \$20,000 for the purchase of a used patrol car. Mr. Haston made a motion and Mr. Robinson seconded the motion to approve the amendment as presented and recommend its passage by the full county commission. On a voice vote, the motion was unanimously approved.

The committee considered six (6) School Federal Projects Fund budget amendments as follows:

1. Title I – Subfund 102: \$169,738.06 for carryover and additional allocation from state
2. Title II, Part A – Subfund 201: \$23,250.66 for carryover and additional allocation from state
3. Title IV – Subfund 401: \$755.38 for allocation reduction from state
4. Title V – Subfund 501: \$5,200.12 for additional allocation from state
5. IDEA Preschool – Subfund 912: \$4,501.73 for additional allocation from state
6. IDEA, Part B – Subfund 901: \$2,872.00 for additional allocation from state
